- What is your method?

- Anything pertinent about how you went about collecting your data?
- STEM- this is where you may want to talk about equipment, tools, etc.

Findings/Discussion

- Finding
 - Describe

Conclusions

- What is the big takeaway from your research?
- How does it contribute to the research on the general topic?
- What are some directions for future research?
- Were there any limitations to the study?
